3. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes:

4. Officer Reports

- **President's Report**
 - Looking into a community partnership with the semi-pro team FC Challenger. Everyone in attendance agreed this would be beneficial.
 - Both travel and rec seasons are underway.
 - All goals were staked down and the nets were secured. We will wait to install new nets prior to fall season.
 - Need to get flyers out to the school for travel evaluations and fall rec by the end of this month.
 - When will evaluations be held?... After the MIST.

- Will CVSA help with evaluations again?... Yes, Peter Byrnes will coordinate with CVSA.
- TeamSnap updated their platform so we will be transitioning to TeamSnap ONE hopefully by the end of this month. We will continue to use TeamSnap Classic for the spring season but it will be obsolete after that.
- **Vice President's Report**
 - Will look into uniform options for this fall or next fall. Uniforms have not changed in several years.
- **Treasurer's Report**
 - Account Ending 5602 Current Balance - \$46,467.21
 - Secondary Account Ending 3154 no changes - \$15,636.23
 - Ref Fees - \$2,765.00
 - TeamSnap - \$749.00
 - US Club Soccer - \$643.30
 - Home Depot - \$15.21
 - Soccer Equipment (Amazon) - \$2,257.13
 - Upcoming expenses:
 - OHTSL Fees - \$990.00
 - Paint - \$1,360.80 (*previous amount did not include tax)
 - Lawn Treatments - \$1,424.62
 - Coach Shirts - \$1,350.00 +/-
 - Goalie Shirts and Gloves - \$540.00 +/-
 - We have raised \$1,865.00 from the basket raffle. This included 6 of the 9 teams. MIST registration fees for these 6 teams total \$3,990.00 +/- . Many of the parents' donations for the baskets were more than what the entry fee would have been for their child. I suggest that BSA covers the balance for these teams so parents are not pulling more money out of their pockets. Board members who were present agreed to cover the balance of MIST fees for the 6 teams who participated in the raffle. Email voting will take place.
 - We will need to decide if we are raising registration fees prior to fall registrations. We are currently at \$185 for travel and \$60 for rec. Board members who were present agreed that \$250 for travel and \$65 for rec are reasonable increases. Email voting will take place.
 - We are bringing in roughly \$40K for rec and travel per year depending on numbers. I estimate we are spending roughly \$35K per year.

- We have made (3) robot payments and have (3) remaining. Each payment is \$5,500.00 per year. Once the robot is paid off the annual fee is reduced to \$1,790.00. By January 2029 BSA will have an additional \$3,710.00 per year.
- Some goals will need welded or replaced. New goals vary but average between \$2K and \$5K.
- **Secretary's Report**
 - No updates.
- **Registrar's Report**
 - Royale was absent.
 - All registrations and player cards are complete for travel.
 - Will need to follow up on any coaches that need to get a background check and complete the SafeSport course.
- **Boys Travel Director Report**
 - No updates.
- **Girls Travel Director Report**
 - Royale was absent.
 - She would like to get player evaluations scheduled for upcoming fall season.
- **Coaching Director's Report**
 - Would like to distribute a calendar and expectations at evaluations for upcoming travel schedule.
 - Would like to host foot skill sessions with money going back to BSA.
 - Will coordinate a rec coaching clinic with Marcie Schwartz from OHTSL. No cost to BSA.
- **Rec Director Report**
 - All rosters have been set. We have 185 kids for this season.
 - Coach bags were distributed. We have 40 rec coaches for this season.
 - Ref fees were distributed.
 - Working on U10 schedule with Medina, Highland, and Cloverleaf.

5. Committee Reports

- 7 days remaining for the basket raffle.

- Drawing will need to be rescheduled as it is currently the same night as the baseball fundraiser.

6. Old Business

- Fill holes and seed. Maybe use sod in goal boxes after spring season ends.
- Some goals need welded or replaced. As of now I know of 4. These are on Fields #6, #7, & #15.
- Still need new numbers for fields 7 through 11 and 13 through 17.
- Repair UTV.
- Install new nets prior to fall season.

- Taxes will need to be filed prior to May 15th.
- Budget will be presented after the fall season ends.
